Market Overview GOLD

USD: We Triggered <u>Sell Signal</u> in USD at 102; the downside projection target to 96 – Met

USD has reached our 1st downside projection of 96, Possibility of bounce. The larger ABC down projection to 92

<u>GOLD</u>; GOLD triggered reentry at PEC-D 1245 within pull back zone CZ 1235-60.

GOLD met our projected ABC up EXACT and pulled back. It should hold CZ 1255-65 levels although one more push down is possible.

FOMC announcement day, GOLD hit highs of 1288 and sold off intraday. The 10 year yield and CPI spread triggered the selloff in spite of yields dropping. GOLD pull back may be within the context of higher highs. Break above 1290 should initiate a very large ABC up.

<u>GDX</u>; Broke out with high volume Bullish top at 23.5 and now pulling back into Gap and CZ 22.40-21.4 with lighter volume. It should be rejecting lows to set up a continuation ABC up.

GDX internals are mixed but improving. The Up / down Volume percent indicator which has made higher lows as GDX made lower lows is a bullish divergence (same condition for Advance/Decline percent- a Bullish divergence). However both indicators are still below "0" which is bearish (but improving).

GDX has made lower lows and the GDX/GLD ratio is matching its previous low showing GDX/GLD ratio is stronger than GDX which is bullish divergences.

Pull back to 22.4 -21.4 should hold and then rally up. GDX projected ABC up to 24.5. The monthly chart for GDX remains bullish. GDX rejected the back CZ 21.4-22.4.

<u>GOLD – Daily chart Analysis</u>

1st Weekly ABC up to 1290 Met with Bullish top. Pull back to CZ 1255-65 should hold and rally up.

GDX – Daily chart Analysis

GDX internals are mixed but improving. GDX – Daily chart Analysis

GDX broke out weekly with high volume Bullish top at 23.5 and pulling back to CZ 22.40-21.4 with lighter volume 1st Weekly ABC up to 24.5.

<u>Critical backdrop Notes –</u>

- Price path Analysis is running commentary of the Market's price behavior, Not a Trade Signal.
- Intermittent CZ's are Short time out / Risk management for overweight position / rebalancing spots. Unless your own Portfolio objective demands.
- POM's are Action points. Also at times Action points are at Main CZ's when specifically announced Triggers.
- Model does not encourage Buying in between unless its false break upside or false break downside soon after POM / Main CZ Trigger and is specifically announced. Model stays with Trend POM to POM Signal.

POM criteria for Implementation on SPX

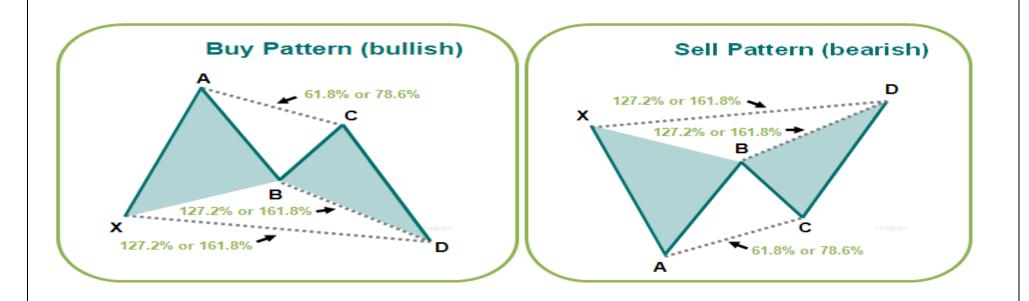
- <u>POM is rated from 10 to 15</u>
- POM 14, 15 (is Sell Signal) and 12, 11 (is Buy Signal) both are the Actionable Area whereas POM 13 is A Neutral Signal for Risk management
- On way <u>UP</u> move, <u>POM 13</u> signifies to <u>STOP</u> executing additional 'New Buys" that was initiated at <u>POM 12</u> or <u>POM 11</u> levels
- On way <u>DOWN</u> move, <u>POM 13</u> signifies to <u>STOP</u> executing additional "New Short Sells" that was initiated at <u>POM 14</u> or <u>POM 15</u> levels
- (Bear Markets) POM 15 is for <u>Net Short</u> & POM 14 is for <u>Hedge Longs</u>
- (Bull Markets) POM 15 is for -<u>Hedge Longs</u> & POM 14 is for <u>Partial Hedge</u>
- POM 12 & 11 is for Net Long
- POM 10 is Climatic Crash low Buy Signal to add to Net long position (Rear event)

Pythagoras Expansion / Contraction – (PEC) Model

- PEC Model is a 2th Derivative Timing Tool utilized on core currencies which identifies the turning point, for Tops and Bottoms on "Short & Intermediate term" Trend in the currency market.
- Methodology is based on Mathematical Pattern Recognition with Symmetrical Pythagoras Triangular expansion and contraction (PEC) in concert with Price Oscillation (POM). This has a high probability for greater accuracy on Price projections at confluence when Integrated together.
- Once our POM analysis is complete, it will overlay PEC. The input signals are from tracking rolling Arithmetic Numerical series of Regression utilizing Fibonacci to Identify Triangular patterns of Expansion / Contraction. Triangular pattern completes at the convergence of 2 separate Fibonacci extension levels and overlay Price Oscillation Model.
- Since the Currency has 2 dimensional pairs, PEC is critical to analyze with 2x2 Fibonacci steams to achieve confluence point D coinciding with POM

PYTHAGORAS EXPANSION / CONTRACTION –(PEC) Model

The output signal of ABCD price moves preceded by a swing high or low (XA) generates projection point D, which is actionable point derived from 2 connecting triangles with convergence ratio. As with all geometric patterns, a Buy or Sell signal occurs as the pattern completes at point D



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
